Create the most beautiful tapestry - creating your own pattern as you weave. Finishing your bag with a leather shoulder strap. Become the envy of all, when you walk in with this exquisite shoulder bag that YOU made. 10" tall x 13" wide x 3" deep. You will be given instructions on how to line the basket and use the liner as the rim filler.

You will be weaving with all dyed reed 3/8" ff and #2 or 3 round - wire, leather, cane, broom tying cord, yarn, fabric, scarves, paper twist and anything that is pliable enough to weave. Jeanne will have lots of different kinds of handles and embellishments. If you have anything that you would like to weave into your basket, please bring it to class.
