Whisk Broom 8:00 – 10:30 am

Utilizing a hand-turned walnut handle, students will use black palmyra to construct a whisk broom for whisking off those small places. Plaiting and sewing the broom will be learned in this class. Make a 2nd whisk for \$25 if time permits.

2-3 hour class Skill: All levels Size: 10 -16” long

Hand Strength a must!

Class: \$30 No kits

Turkey Wing Whisk Broom – 10:30 am – 1 pm

Utilizing a leather thong handle, students will use natural and some dyed broom corn to construct a turkey wing whisk broom for whisking off those small places. Plaiting with leather will be learned in this class. The turkey wing will be tied with string and not wire. Student may make a second one for \$30 if time permits.

2-3 hour class Skill: All levels

Size: 12-18” long

Kitchen Broom – 1:30 – 5:30 pm

Utilizing a special stick, students will use broom corn to construct a kitchen broom that is totally useful. Plaiting and sewing the broom will be learned in this class. Bring a special stick or hard wood or choose one from Jeanne's supply (1/2" - 1" dia., 36" – 42" long). All of the plaiting will be done with leather strips with lots of colored cord to choose from.

Hand Strength a must!

4 hour class Skill: All levels

Size: 48" - 52" long

Cost: \$45 No kits

Cobweb Brooms – 1:30 – 5:30 pm

Utilizing a special stick, students will use broom corn to construct a cobweb broom for reaching those high places. Plaiting and sewing the broom will be learned in this class. Bring a special stick or hard wood or choose one from Jeanne's stock (1/2" – 1" dia., 16" -24" long or longer)

4 hour class Skill: All levels

Size: 36 – 50" long
